

Survey: Landscaping seen as big benefit

Twenty-eight residents responded to the online survey about Sabal Point issues and priorities announced in the March newsletter. Although the responses were too few to draw conclusions about the views of residents in general, they do offer a glimpse of what residents are thinking:

The HOA service seen as “most valuable” by the largest number of respondents – 80 percent – was the landscaping of common areas.

Almost half said they were familiar with Florida-Friendly Landscaping practices and wanted the HOA to use them as much as possible.

And on the question of what to do about aging wooden street signs in need of repair, 44 percent said the signs should be turned over to Seminole County for maintenance.
